It was such an honour to judge at this the oldest Bulldog Club and the one I was associated within my early years. A big Thank You to all the exhibitors for their entry and sportsmanship. The Committee had worked so hard to get the venue looking lovely and the hospitality was very nice.

I last judged this breed in 2019 and each time I visit this breed it improves. I was just sorry that one had to be withdrawn for temperament. Overall, the bites were very good although there were just one or two of wry mouths. I found a couple of dogs I would have loved to have consider for further consideration but were just not giving it their all for the handler.

Minor Puppy Dog (5,3Abs)

1. Haddaway Hey Bulldog - Excellent in balance and shape but still must develop in hind quarters. The head piece was beautiful with his lovely skull, lay of foreface and turn up of jaw good open nostrils eye conformation and rose ears all this at 8 months. Good top line, neck, and front quarters. Movement was good in profile and front action. Best Dog Puppy
2. Captainbull !'m Bronson – Not quite the balance and shape of 1. Head properties good for age. Hind quarters a little straight however his movement was good from all angles.

Puppy Dog (4,1Abs)

1. Bulldurham Jack The Lad – Excellent balance and shape with very good head properties and neck. Does not always hold a correct top line. Very good movement
2. Bagibeli Marvelous Marvin at Seehurst – Good balance but would have preferred a better shape and darker eye. Excellent bone. And very good movement.
3. Blenheimstar Solace

Junior Dog (6,1Abs)

1. Mireman Nano for Onabazz – 14 months whose excellent shape when viewed from all angles and balance gave him the class. Good tail set. Excellent quarters with front supporting a very good strong neck leading to an excellent top line. Very good head properties with excellent sweep of jaw, open nostrils, and eye conformation. The movement was excellent all around giving typical breed type and movement. I was pleased to award him the Dog CC and Best in Show.
2. Chayo White Knight at Chelseapride – Balance and shape very good. Head properties generally, very good. Good front quarters, top line, and neck. Movement good in profile.
3. Shenko Mr White

Yearling Dog (4,1Abs)

1. Baalzebul Cupid's Beau - 14 months showing very good balance and shape an all-round very good dog with excellent front quarters, top line, and neck and very good movement when viewed from all angles. Head properties are very good including eye confirmation and ears. Res. Dog CC
2. Avaword Dexter – An all-round good dog however not quite the balance of
1. Very good top line and neck. Head properties pleased. Movement confirmed by construction.
3. Kelloe White Knight

Novice Dog (3,2Abs)

1. Miristar Rocyn Rebel – An all-round excellent dog from shape through to head properties, quarters, and movement but for me I would have preferred a better bite.

Post Graduate Dog (7,2Abs)

1. Chezzasbully Mountbatten – Upstanding male with balance and excellent shape and good tail set. Very good head properties from skull through to jaw, eye conformation and ear placement. Good all-round movement.
2. Ladymere Kingston – a standard size male who I thought was going to be my surprise of the day with very good balance, shape and tail length but would have preferred a better set. Very good head properties, eyes, and ears. I liked his quarters, top line and neck. His movement that I was able to see was very good such a pity he would not perform.
3. Bullmont Lord of the Manor

Limit Dog (15,6Abs)

1. Pleats Platinum Edition – Excellent balance, shape, and quarters with good tail set. Head properties, top line, and neck very good. Excellent all-round movement.
2. Wilsonpride Shockwave – Not quite the make and development of quarters to 1st place. But an all-round dog with no outstanding exaggerations defiantly deserving of this place in this the largest class of the day.
3. Forget Me Never – a very good dog but not giving his all today.

Open Dog (10,5Abs)

1. Ch The Crown of the Bulldog Carte D'or {AY76664ESP} – It was good to have the pleasure of going over this talked about dog of standard size with everything in its right place and deserved this placing however for me he was more like a model than a live specimen with excellent movement from all quarters but not quite the flexibility.
2. BR/SP Ch Will Be Bulls Optimus prime {AX00157POL} – Upstanding in front quarters and excellent hind quarters, good neck, and general movement very good. Shows

very good head properties. To be critical I would like him a tad shorter in back.

3. New Soul Origin of Belushi

Veteran Dog or Bitch (2,1Abs)

1. Ragmarte Lilly Pad as Blenheimstar – 7 1/2yr old bitch with excellent movement, balance and shape.

Minor Puppy Bitch (8,4Abs)

1. Gasholi Starlight Evie – 7months beautifully put together baby of excellent balance and body shape. Good tail set. Excellent front and rear quarters, top line, and neck. Having considered the head properties I found the skull, lay of foreface, nose and jaw very good for age. Very good eye conformation and colour. Lovely use of ears. The movement was so breed typical. Res. Bitch CC & Best Bitch Puppy leading to

2. Wilsonpride Love is the Law – The balance, shape and quarters of this girl pleased. Head properties very good with an excellent jaw and nostrils. Good ears and set. Generally, movement pleased.

3. Majentabull Miss Vuitton NAF

Puppy Bitch (5,1Abs)

1. Wingbrook La Petite Coco – 8-month standard size with balance, shape, and tail set that pleased. Head properties pleasing as were the eyes and ear set. Good quarters, top line and neck. All round movement very good. This girl just needs a little more confidence in the show ring.

2. Bagibeli Dancing Queen – The excellent movement confirmed her construction and movement with very good shape and tail. Head properties generally very good. Just a little masculine all round for me.

3. Ragmarte Reach for the Stars

Junior Bitch (11,4Abs)

1. Chayo Carvalho at Chelseapride – showing excellent head properties, eyes, and ears also balance. General shape, tail set, top line and neck pleased. A little straight in hind quarters however her movement was very good.

2. Emma Bright Diamond – All over very good balance/shape, head properties and movement. I would have preferred a better hind action.

3. Miristar Roces Rockabye

Yearling Bitch (7,3Abs)

1. Ladymere Fenty – Upstanding with very good balance, shape, tail, and quarters. Pleasing head properties with good brick shape skull. Very good quarters and neck. Like her front movement and general all-round action.

2. Avaword Temptress at Ballesmar – Heavier head type than 1 but with good lay of

foreface. Good top line and neck, tail set and shape which showed very good general balance. A little straight on hind quarters.

3. Linda Callejaca

Maiden Bitch (2)

1. Britishpride Faberges – Very good general balance, shape, and tail set. Excellent head properties. I liked her rear quarters. Movement confirmed construction.

2. Avaword Shira – General balance and shape good. Hind quarters a little straight. Movement good.

Post Graduate Bitch (7,4Abs)

1. Testwood Killer Queen for Boyattbull – Upstanding balanced with good shape. Excellent head properties, eyes, and ear set. Quarters both very good with good movement from all angles. Good top line.

2. Chezzasbully She's Dotty – Standard size very good though out. Would prefer a little less weight this would improve.

3. Terlingfair Flaming Star

Limit Bitch (7,2Abs)

1. Sandars Miss Agnes – Upstanding standard size with excellent balance and shape. Good tail and set. Excellent head properties with turn up of jaw, lay of foreface, eye confirmation and lovely ear set of rose shape. Excellent movement, top line, and neck that showed off her lovely front and rear quarters. Bitch CC BOS ResBiS

2. Rosebulls Edith – All in its right place where movement confirmed construction with excellent head properties.

3. Captainbull Bonnie

Open Bitch (8,3Abs)

1. Starbornbullies Xena at Mellowmood (IKC) NAF TAF {AZ40551IKC} – I really thought this would be my second surprise of the day as she entered the ring, and it did not displease me when I examined her in the stand position. Unfortunately, she did not play ball with her handler on the move however with her quality and seeing sufficient movement won the class.

2. Captainbull She's Esme – upstanding with excellent shape and head properties. Very good quarters showing excellent movement but not quite the quality of 1.
